

Suggested Questions for *R. Leo Sprinkle, Ph.D.*

1. As a psychologist, you take a very different perspective by linking reincarnation and UFO activity. Please explain that connection.
2. Why do you think that the concept of reincarnation is difficult for some people to consider?
3. What kinds of evidence are available for the concept of reincarnation?
4. When did you know that you would study UFO experiences and why did you start on that path?
5. What kinds of evidence are available for the existence of UFO's?
6. With the mounting evidence of UFOs, why do you think people choose to ignore the research?
7. What do your colleagues say about your interests in reincarnation and UFO experiences and did it cause any problems for you professionally?
8. How many persons have you surveyed about their views of reincarnation and their possible other lifetimes?
9. How many persons have you surveyed about their UFO experiences?
10. How many persons have you assisted to explore their memories of ET encounters?
11. What is the practical benefit of accepting the claims of recalling possible other lives?
12. In addition, what is the practical benefit of accepting the evidence for UFO/ET encounters?
13. What do you feel are the reasons for the historically strong denial for reincarnation?
14. How did you begin your studies of "psychological resonance" or "life readings"? And please explain in more detail what a "life reading" is.
15. What is your speculation about the reasons for a coverup of UFO evidence?
16. Do you believe that a coverup of evidence for reincarnation is also taking place?
17. Is there support for the view that "new science" can foster research in reincarnation and UFO/ET encounters?
